Objective

The purpose of this stage of the programme is to obtain the definition and hierarchical organisation of the zones of priority interest.

Tasks




- ✿ Definition of criteria
- ✿ Analysis of data
- ✿ Dissemination/Validation of results

Time frame



- ✿ Project meeting of February 2007: definition of criteria
- ✿ From February 2007 to August 2007: introduction of data into Noria, analysis and discussions between partners
- ✿ Project meeting of August 2007: validation of the results and dissemination to provinces actors

Outcome and deliverables

Outcome:

-  Definition of the groups of villages and hierarchical organisation of the priority zones
-  Validation of the zones proposed by the national institutional and political actors.
-  Implication of the regional energy and rural development actors.

Deliverables:

-  Validated list of the zones of priority interest
-  Publication of the results on the project website.

Roles of partners

- ✿ FONDEM: conducts the analysis phase for the hierarchical organisation of the zones. Presentation, during Project Meeting, of the results of the work package to the partners and concerned actors of the studied provinces.
- ✿ FRAUNHOFER: co-participation in the analysis phase.
- ✿ CRA-W: participation in the analysis phase, especially on biomass energy aspects.
- ✿ DET, DOE, RERD: in charge of the representativeness of the local actors and institutions of each of their countries (province heads, district representatives) during Project Meetings. Co-validation of the zones of priority interest and leader of the meeting to present the results to the regional actors.
